

## REQUIREMENTS FOR PHILIPPINE VISA

(As of 21 November 2024)

1. Appointment with the Consular Section of the Philippine Embassy in Hanoi, to be scheduled through [hanoipe.visa@dfa.gov.ph](mailto:hanoipe.visa@dfa.gov.ph).
2. Duly accomplished Visa Application Forms
3. One (1) recent colored ID photo (4.5cm x 3.48cm)
4. Proof of *bona fide* status as tourist or businessman
5. Proof of legal residence
6. Confirmed tickets for return or onward journey to the next port of destination

Note: ***Other relevant documents may be required by the Consular Officer, if necessary. Additional requirements may be conveyed through email following the initial request for appointment through [hanoipe.visa@dfa.gov.ph](mailto:hanoipe.visa@dfa.gov.ph).***

### IMPORTANT:

Nationals from countries listed below who are traveling to the Philippines for business and tourism purposes are allowed to enter the Philippines without visas for a stay not exceeding thirty (30) days, provided: (1) they hold valid tickets for their return journey to port of origin or next port of destination, and (2) their passports are valid for a period of at least six (6) months beyond the contemplated period of stay.

Nationals from the following countries are allowed to enter the Philippines without a visa for a period of stay of thirty (30) days or less:

*\*Nationals of these countries are allowed to enter the Philippines without a visa for a stay not exceeding fifty-nine (59) days based on existing agreements.*

The following are allowed to enter the Philippines without a visa for a stay not exceeding fourteen (14) days:

1. Holders of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region (SAR) passports
2. Holders of Macau Special Administrative Region (SAR) passports

The following are allowed to enter the Philippines without a visa for a stay not exceeding seven (7) days:

1. Holders of Macau-Portuguese passports
2. Holders of Hong Kong British passports
